## A child's Christmas curiosity can lead to a holiday tragedy

A child's delight in tree decorations, pine wreaths, and wrapping paper highlight the season's joys for a holiday. But a child's curiosity and excitement can lead to a holiday tragedy.

Dr. George Rogers, medical director of Kentucky Regional Hospital, said that many children are attracted to the bright colors and textures of decorations. He noted that children are often attracted to the shiny, reflective surfaces of decorations, which can be dangerous if swallowed.

Other decorations, such as "angel hair" and bubble lights, pose special problems if chewed or swallowed. "Angel hair" is spun glass which may be hazardous if swallowed, and irritates the skin.

Bubble lights are glass balls filled with ethyl alcohol, ethyl ether, or methylene chloride. All of these liquids are very dangerous if swallowed.

Some decorations, however, are not toxic if swallowed. Examples of natural and synthetic candles, and plastic or aluminum tinsel are usually not harmful. After children examine decorations with adult supervision, place those decorations out of a child's reach.
