for 12 percent of cigarette sales, supermarkets for 8 percent. Tobacco taxes are one of the Federal government's chief sources of revenue. Today more than \$1 billion is paid each year to Federal, state, county and municipal treasuries in tobacco taxes. More than half the receipts from retail sales of cigarettes go to the various governmental tax-collectors. Since 1962, when cigarettes were added to the tax rolls, governments at all levels have collected over \$144 billion in tobacco taxes. Cigarettes have accounted for 34.5 percent of that, or 12.34 billion.

The backdrop and foundation of the great tobacco industry is the grower, the tobacco farmer and his family. A recent study by the University of Pennsylvania's Wharton Applied Research Center showed that over a half-million Americans worked full or part-time on 196,000 tobacco farms in 22 states.

The independent study also showed that the tobacco-growing sector contributed \$847 million to other segments of the economy through purchases of goods and services, including equipment, fertilizer, seed, energy and insurance.

Tobacco farming and manufacturing contributed an estimated \$7.4 billion to the U.S. economy, or about 13 times the expenditures on tobacco and tobacco products.

It takes 250 man-hours to grow an acre of tobacco compared to 2 1/2 hours of labor to produce an acre of corn, or three hours for wheat.

No wonder the tobacco farmer calls it a "13-month" crop.
