Copyright 1962. I'm delighted to have the book because I collect cookbooks, old or new, like other people collect stamps, minerals, or what have you.

Happy Valentine's Day... The book is divided into three parts: Family Dinners, Dinners for Occasions, Company and Formal Dinners. Some interesting things noted in the book - In the 24 menus listed for family dinners, cake was never listed for dessert. All the desserts were puddings, ice cream or baked fruit, usually apples, and sometimes topped with a meringue. The one cake mentioned in the book was a Sponge Cake listed in a menu for Dinners for Occasions, and that was for a Thanksgiving dinner. The recipe:

SPONGE CAKE... Yolks of 4 eggs... 1/4 cup powdered sugar... 1/2 cup milk... 1/2 cup flour... 1/2 cup butter... 2 eggs... 1 teaspoon flour... 1/2 cup milk... 2 cups flour... 3 teaspoons baking powder... 1 cup raisins... Shredded almonds... Powdered sugar...
