Shortage of math, science teachers approaches crisis

"Kentucky took the lead in dealing with the shortage of qualified math and science teachers, but we've only scratched the surface," McDonald said. "What we need is a national focus."

McDonald referred to Kentucky's incentive program for college students which provides a debt-free loan for those who major in math or science, earn a teaching certificate and teach in a Kentucky public school in those fields.

"The central theme of this entire issue is the student loan," she said. "Students are no longer making course selections in math and science, and, as a result, test scores are falling down in those areas."

The United States must gear up to compete with technology in other countries, McDonald warned.

"We cannot afford not to channel resources into the education of our future national leaders."

Forest Service offers Springtime tree planting help

Perhaps one of the most lasting legacies one can leave is a stand of healthy trees planted by one's own hands. Such a plantation can provide many benefits, including income from the timber, wildlife habitat, recreational opportunities and aesthetic charm.

Obviously, when someone goes to the time and effort of planting trees, he wants to do his best to ensure the survival and subsequent growth of his seedlings.

One of the first questions asked is invariably, "What should I plant?" It is important to select certain tree species (including black walnut and yellow poplar) as very specific about where they will grow, while other species (such as shortleaf and Virginia pine) will grow almost anywhere. Another major consideration is species selection for the reason for planting the trees. Do you want to grow high-quality veneer logs, provide food and cover for game, create a windbreak or visual barrier, or just a touch of beauty to enhance your lifestyle? These objectives are not mutually exclusive, and with proper planning, many different uses can be managed for at the same time.

The Kentucky Division of Forestry offers advice and technical assistance to those interested in planting trees. The Division also maintains tree nurseries to provide landowners with the trees they need.
