

Exemption As a service to the property owner eligible for the Disability Homestead Exemption, I will carry the exemption over to the 1983 tax bill for those already receiving it.

However, each disability recipient will have to re-apply for the exemption by December 31, 1983, showing proof that he/she is still totally disabled and has received the disability from Social Security, Veteran's Administration, or Railroad Retirement for the 12 full months of 1983.

If a person does not qualify for the entire year the exemption will be voided and the 1983 taxes due on the amount of exemption.
