very slowly breathing.

Weak pulse; low blood pressure.

Confusion, disorientation or drowsiness.

Lack of coordination; sluggishness.

If any of these symptoms exist, take the victim's temperature. If it is below 90 degrees F or does not register, call a doctor or an ambulance. While waiting for help to arrive, prevent further heat loss by wrapping the victim in a warm blanket; use hot water bottles, and if the victim is alert, give him/her small quantities of warm food and drink. If nothing else is available, lie next to the victim and use your body heat to keep the victim warm.

"Hypothermia can be a dangerous health condition," says Attorney General Beshear. "Take precautions and use these guidelines to help prevent this from happening to you or your loved ones."

Birth month vehicle registration to help

The new birth month vehicle registration should eliminate the long lines that form at county clerk's offices around Kentucky — but not until 1984.

This year, Kentucky will have the first year of its new birth month registration program. This year, registration will be held on the first of each month. The program will be phased in over a three-year period.

"The new registration system will bring some long-awaited relief to the state's motorists," said Tim Helton, commissioner of the Department of Transportation.

"But this year will be similar to last year. In fact, with the changes in the registration process, lines may move down," Helton said.

His advice is simple: "Don't wait until the end of the month to register on your car."

The state's 120 county clerk offices approved legislation that changes the registration process.

This year, motorists can register their cars until their birth month is 1983 or 1984. Small trucks, 4,000 pounds or less, will also be registered in the owner's birth month. Small truck tags expire April 1 this year.

In addition to the birth month registration, the law separated the registration certificate from the title. The title certificate is the proof of ownership to use when trading or selling the vehicle. The registration is a receipt for paying taxes to drive on Kentucky roads.
