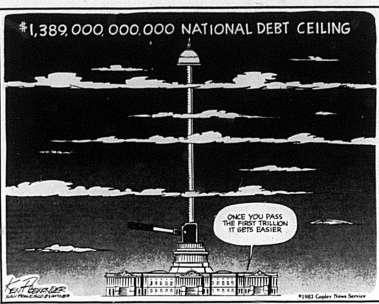
Retired teacher is proud of her County heritage
