13 year old All Stars win district championship

The Nicholas County 13 year old Babe Ruth All Stars defeated Montgomery County 11 to 6 in the final game of the District 12 tournament Monday at Nicholas County High School. The win marked the first district championship for a Nicholas County team in 13 years of Babe Ruth League competition.

Nicholas finished the tournament the way it began by defeating Montgomery County in the double elimination event. Scheduled between the Montgomery games was a 142 victory over Powell County.

Montgomery County peaked away scoring unearned runs in the second, third and fifth innings to take a 3-0 lead. Nicholas jumped on top in the seventh as Meredith Nicholas was safe on an error by shortstop Jeff Taylor.
