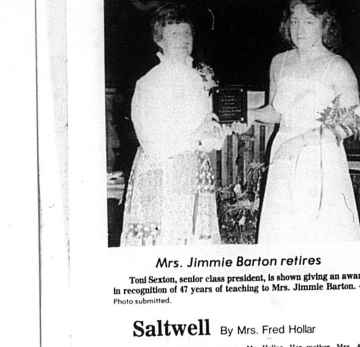

Avenues of appeal when you disagree with the IRS

The Internal Revenue Service has just examined your federal tax returns. The examiner says you owe; you say you don't. What's your next move? Try negotiating? Not at all, says IRS. If that happens, you have several avenues of appeal. First, if the examiner looks over an IRS office, ask to speak to the examiner's supervisor. You may be able to resolve your case then and there. Should you come to an agreement, you may sign an agreement form, which indicates your acceptance of the amount shown on the return. But if you don't agree after talking with the supervisor, or if the examination was made in accordance with an IRS office and you still disagree, you will receive a transmittal letter from IRS, notifying you of the amount of the adjustment. If you disagree with the amount of the adjustment, you may appeal to the Tax Court. If you are not satisfied with the Tax Court's decision, you may appeal to the U.S. Court of Appeals. If you are not satisfied with the U.S. Court of Appeals' decision, you may appeal to the U.S. Supreme Court.
