**BOND SALES LOW**  
Roger Winesick, Nicholas County Savings Bond Chairman, reported purchases of \$111 in United States Savings Bonds were credited to the county for January 1983. Only five Kentucky counties reported bond sales.

United States Savings Bonds totaled \$136,077 for January 1983 according to reports coming to the County Chairman from Dennis R. Honora, President and CEO of Texas Gas Transmission Corporation, the Kentucky State Volunteer Chairman for the U.S. Savings Bonds Division.

Beginning Nov. 1, 1982, new Series EE Savings Bonds held at least five years earn market-based interest, 85 percent of the average yield on one-year Treasury marketable securities. Older Series EE and most Series E Bonds also earn market-based interest if held at least five years beyond Nov. 1, 1982. The interest rate for the first six months under this system is 11.00 percent.

### Pre-school registration

Pre-registration will be conducted at Nicholas County Elementary School, Thursday, March 23, beginning at 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Parents interested in registering their child for Head Start, kindergarten or first grade for the 1983-84 school term should register on this date.

To be eligible to enroll in kindergarten the child must be five or six years of age on or before Oct. 1, 1983. A child must be six years of age on or before Oct. 1, 1983 to be eligible for entry to first grade.

Parents will need to bring a copy of the child's birth verification. If your child was born in Kentucky you may obtain a birth verification card upon request from the Nicholas County Health Center.

Parents interested in registering their child for Head Start will need to provide birth verification. In some verification and parent social security number.
