## USDA proposes the rules on burley quotas

On April 22, the U.S. Department of Agriculture proposed rules to implement legislation which requires serious not significantly involved in the management or use of land for agricultural purposes to either sell or forfeit their burley or flue-cured tobacco acreage allocations and marketing quotas.

The legislation, the No Net Cost Tobacco Act of 1982, does not include individuals, but does include governmental entities, public utilities, educational institutions and religious institutions, among others.  
According to Everett Rank, administrator of USDA's Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service, quotas must be sold by Dec. 31, 1983, or Dec. 31 of the year after the year in which the farm is acquired, whichever is later. If the quota is not sold by the applicable date, the person shall forfeit the quota to the county Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Committee, he said. The proposed rules also set down
