Bargain meat prices balance food costs

Bargain prices for meat during October registered higher take on several other food products, leading to a slight decline in average retail food costs, according to Kentucky Farm Bureau's marketbasket survey.

The index of prices for 46 selected food items stood at \$8.98 for October, versus below last month's level of \$9.03. In comparison, the marketbasket average was 14 cent lower last month.

All three primary meat varieties — beef, pork and poultry — registered declines at retail counters during the month. Beef was four percent lower than in September, pork was nearly

two percent lower and poultry declined 18 percent. Overall, the 13 meat cuts on the survey averaged 2.4 percent below September levels.

By contrast, the other three major components of the marketbasket increased in price. Dairy products, despite a healthy drop in milk prices, averaged two percent higher, vegetables and fruits were 17 percent higher and grain-based foods climbed nearly four percent.

The price of two percent milk, which dropped to an average \$1.79 a gallon, was at its lowest level since September 1937. Whole milk declined as well, averaging \$2.01 per gallon. Other dairy products posted significant price increases, however, including butter, up 15 cents a pound, and American and cheddar cheeses, up 18 and 19 cents a pound respectively.

Other products showing moderate to large jumps in cost were eggs, up six cents a dozen, cucumbers, 15 cents higher, apples, and lettuce, which posted a hike of 23 cents a head, to 95 cents. Corn oil was up 13 cents a bottle and potato chips were seven cents higher a 10-cent bag.

On the opposite side of the ledger, lamb chops, apples and beef costed less. The list of items which moved sharply downward in price: Potatoes fell by 14 cents for a 16-pound bag, and apples marked a seasonal decline of 17 cents a pound. Three of the highest quality beef cuts, rib eye steak, T-bone steak and tri-tip roast, were off in price from 15 to 27 cents a pound.

Greenburg had the lowest local marketbasket for October, while Madisonville checked in at the high end of the range. Volant surveyers working through Farm Bureau women maintained list prices in 25 Kentucky communities.

Some of the local marketbasket figures are Greenburg, \$8.20; Scottsville, \$8.30; Morehead, \$8.40; Cynthiana, \$8.51; Troy Ridge, \$8.64; Middlesboro, \$8.66; Georgetown, \$8.82; Louisville, \$8.79; Lexington, \$8.48.
