Newman attends UK's Institute of English Humanities

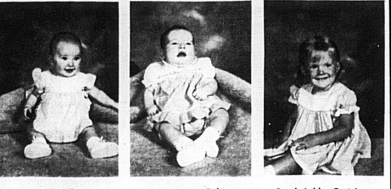
