Kay's Kitchen

It is not too early to start thinking about Easter meals. You may want to do something extra for breakfast, dinner, supper or maybe a brunch. Whatever you decide, anything you can do ahead of time will make the task easier. Even if you are not going to have guests, something special for your family will be appreciated. I will start this week with some Easter breads. The following basic yeast dough brings simplicity, some baking. The recipe can be used for Apricot Nut Coffee Cake, Cinnamon Rolls, or seed pans.

APRICOT NUT COFFEE CAKE
4 1/2 cups unsifted flour
1/2 cup sugar
1 teaspoon salt
2 packages of yeast
1/4 cup milk
1/2 cup water
1/2 cup margarine
2 eggs

In large bowl, thoroughly mix 1 cup flour, salt and undissolved yeast. Combine milk, water and margarine in a saucepan. Heat over low heat until liquids are very warm (130-135 degrees). Margarine does not need to be completely melted. Gradually add dry ingredients and beat 2 minutes at constant speed of electric mixer, scraping bowl occasionally. Add 1/2 cup flour and two eggs. Beat at high speed 3 minutes, scraping bowl occasionally. Add enough additional flour to make a very stiff batter. Cover lightly and refrigerate at least 2 hours or up to 2 days.

Turn out onto floured board, divide into 2 equal parts. Use each piece of dough for each bread or cake.

APRICOT FILLING
Combine 1/2 cup apricot preserves, 1/4 cup chopped nuts (pecans or English walnuts) and 1 teaspoon grated lemon rind. Set aside. Roll out one piece of dough in 8x12-inch rectangle. Spread to graham baking sheet. Spread filling down center third of rectangle. Stick apricots along both sides of filling, leaving from filling out to edge of dough. Fold apricot at an angle across
