Rep. Perkins dead at 71
Services were held Tuesday in Hodgman for U.S. Rep. Carl D. Perkins, a member of Congress from the 7th District for 26 years, who died Friday in Lexington. Perkins collapsed at Blue Grass Airport after arriving on a flight from Washington. Perkins, 71, had a long history of heart problems and had been hospitalized earlier last week at Walter Reed Army Medical Center after complications of chest pains, apparently attributed to a cold. U.S. Senator Wendell Ford, D-Ky., said: "His patient hard work in the House of Representatives enabled him to accomplish much for Kentucky and the nation. As chairman of the House Education and Labor Committee he had a giant hand in shaping the growth of our nation's schools and colleges."
