Election hindsight

A recent New Times-CBS poll reports that Americans' confidence in government has risen sharply under President Reagan and support for the Republican Party is at its highest level in more than a decade, with the strongest backing coming from the young.

Democratic state party leaders, William Hamblin, Jr. warned that although the party's losses seemed confined to the presidential race, "Republicanism was 54 percent of the vote in contested congressional races, carried young and first-time voters and made inroads on party identification," he said.

Garrett, Walter Mondale's national co-chairman, said: "Our problems go deeper than Ronald Reagan's grin. We are losing our ideal as a party, our progress.
