In accordance with the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, the second Organizational Session of the Kentucky General Assembly will convene at 10 o'clock on Jan. 7, 1965. House and Senate will convene in their respective chambers.

The first Organizational Session two years ago was rather brief due to the fact that neither the House nor the Senate had held regular sessions prior to convening. The Organizational Session is required to last no longer than 10 legislative days. We expect to be able to complete our business in only four days in 1965.

The purpose is to convene in those very elected members of the General Assembly. Only the House of Representatives held its last election in 1963 when it lasted over 90 days.

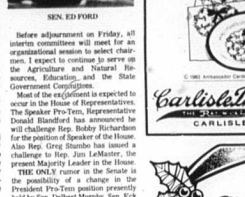
