**FARMER BEET**  
SET-ANDE DEADLINE  
IN DECEMBER 31  
Farmers have only until December 31  
to let the Farmers Home Administration  
(FHA) know if they want to be  
considered for setting aside part of their  
FARMA farm debt. Don Tandy, Franklin  
County Supervisor, has announced.  
Any farmer who thinks he or she  
might be eligible for the special set aside  
program should contact me without  
delay so we can make an appointment,"  
Tandy said. "The actual meeting can be  
held any time, but the deadline for  
submitting the application is Dec. 31."  
Under the program, which is part of  
President Reagan's farm credit  
initiatives announced in September,  
FARMA can set aside for five years  
without interest as much as 25 percent,  
up to a maximum of \$20,000 of a  
borrower's FARMA debt if that will  
reduce a positive cash flow for the  
farmer.  
Borrowers have 30 days after  
receiving notice of the program from  
FARMA to ask for an appointment to  
discuss the program.
