When meal preparation time is limited, main dishes that are quick and easy come in handy. For example, this one-dish skillet meal, Noodle Con Carne, cooks in about 15 minutes. After the meat is lightly browned, all ingredients are added to layers. The dry noodle cook pump and tender in liquid.

**NOODLE CON CARNE:** 1 pound lean ground beef, 1/2 lb. cheddar cheese, drained, 4 egg whites, 1 1/2-lb. jar (16 oz.) can whole tomatoes, chopped, 1 teaspoon salt, 1/2 teaspoon pepper, 1 teaspoon onion powder.

**DEVILED EGG BAKE:** 4 hard-boiled eggs, 2 teaspoons prepared mustard, 1/2 cup blue cheese dressing, 1/2 teaspoon salt, 2 tablespoons margarine, 1/2 cup chopped green pepper, 1/2 cup chopped onion, 1 can Cream of Mushroom soup, 1/2 cup shredded cheddar cheese.

1 cup chopped onion, 1 cup chopped celery, 1 tablespoon margarine or butter, 1/2 cup grated cheddar cheese, 2 eggs, 1 cup milk, 1/2 teaspoon seasoned salt, 1/2 teaspoon pepper, 1/2 teaspoon paprika.

Cut crusts from bread if desired. Fit four slices into bottom of a glass square baking dish or 8-inch square cake pan. Saute onion and celery in margarine until limp; sprinkle over bread in dish. Add cheese. Cover with remaining bread. Beat eggs; add milk, salt, pepper and paprika. Mixing well, pour over bread in casserole. Cover and bake in preheated oven at 350 degrees for 45 minutes. Let stand for 5 minutes before serving.

Beat margarine in large skillet; add green pepper and onion until tender. Remove from heat; stir in tomatoes, soup and remaining milk. Place 1/2 of the soup mixture in 1/2 quart shallow baking dish. Arrange eggs, cut side up, in single layer over soup. Sprinkle with paprika. Bake at 350 degrees for 20 minutes or until heated through. Casserole may be assembled in advance. Refrigerate until ready to bake.
