Unemployed drop

The unemployment rate in Nicholas and seven other Kentucky counties between August and September, according to a report by the Bureau of Economic Analysis, fell to 12.1 percent in September from 12.7 percent in August. The figures reflect the statewide rate decrease from a revised 12.7 percent in August to a preliminary 12.1 percent in September. The rate dropped from 12.9 percent in August to 12.1 percent in September.
