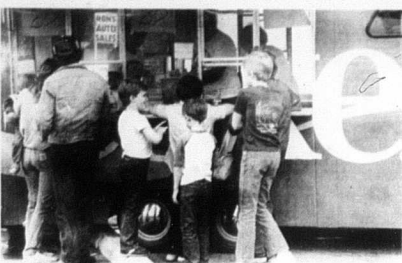


'Schools of the Future' study predicts change to individual education
