**REFURBISHING OF ROAD SIGNS SAVES BIG DUCKS**  
 State Transportation Secretary Floyd G. Pate announces that the Transportation Cabinet has saved \$60,000 by working with another state agency. "The Transportation Cabinet is just effort to refurbish road signs which have been damaged," said Pate. "This program is very cost effective. The savings to the Transportation Cabinet over the first nine months of the Caltrans Administration is great." Pate said Ron Durham, director of Correctional Industries, implemented the sign refurbishing industry at the Kentucky State Reformatory in LaGrange. Durham said that under this new program, 75,000 road signs have been refurbished by 18 inmates and one supervisor.
