FORMER LESLIE COUNTY JUDGE EXECUTIVE TO BE GUEST ON KET'S 'BYWORDS'

George Weston, former county judge executive for Leslie County, will be the guest of Howard Meyer III on the Jan. 23 edition of "Bywords," the program which will be aired at 7 p.m. on KET. Weston will be joined by other guests at Hill for Certain in Leslie County, Hamilton, Ohio but returned after the death of his mother, when he was four years old. Weston explains how families were separated and how he was raised in a foster home in Leslie County, Ky. Weston worked his way through the school at Buckhorn.

Weston served in the Third Army under Gen. George Patton during World War II for four years and the county judge executive for 12 years. He loves people, enjoys politics and says that he is a "flexible" Republican, voting for whom he considers the best person for the job. He also says that he feels that a judge has to be a sympathetic, reasonable and honest man.

Asked about his main accomplishments as judge executive, Weston says that the installation of water and sewage treatment systems during his tenure did most to improve the county, as well as the sewer repair system that he helped to start.

"The Life and Death of King John," one of Shakespeare's lesser-known but exciting plays, is the centennial anniversary series, "The Shakespeare Play," featuring a distinguished cast headed by Charles Blount and the late Leonard Fowler. "King John" airs on KET Monday, Jan. 14, at 8 p.m.

"King John" is best remembered as the man who was forced by his barons to sign the Magna Carta. School children know him as the medieval monarch of the "Table Rock" series. Shakespeare presents him as a second-rate king - avaricious, vacillating and weak. The play focuses on the disparity between respect due the office and respect due the man who holds it.

Essential skills now to include writing, spelling, library use

The State Board of Education has issued a list of essential skills to be taught in Kentucky schools to ensure that students are prepared for the workforce. The list, approved by the board at its meeting at Murray High School on Wednesday, Nov. 28, includes the identification of essential skills ordered by the State General Assembly in Session of 1984. The board previously adopted essential skills in reading, writing and mathematics.

The board also approved a code of ethics to ensure the integrity of student achievement tests to be given at all levels from kindergarten through the 12th grade beginning next year.

Dr. of Public Instruction Alice McDonald said the code was developed to provide consistent guidelines for the administration and supervision of the tests and to allay doubts about the credibility of the state testing program.

Nicholas unemployment for November is 5.1 percent

November 1984 brought higher unemployment rates in 26 Kentucky counties, seven rates for 26 counties and left rates unchanged for the other three counties in the state, according to figures released by the Cabinet for Human Resources.

There were 58 counties reporting unemployment rates in November of 10 percent or higher, compared to 54 in October and 51 in November 1983.

Statutory unemployment rates in November were 4.9 percent, the same as in October, but down from November 1983, when it was 6.4 percent. Nationally the comparable rates were 6.9 percent in November, 7 percent in October and 7.1 percent in November 1983. The rates are not seasonally adjusted.

In the Lexington metropolitan area the unemployment rate dropped from a revised rate of 4.9 percent in October to a preliminary rate of 3.8 percent in November. In the area comprised of Boyle, Bourbon, Clark, Jessamine, Scott and Woodford counties, employment decreased from 18,907 in October to 18,227 in November, with unemployment dropping from 4.67 to 3.77 during the same period. NEMATODE WORK SWITCHED TO PRINCETON

All Kentucky soil samples for which nematode analysis is desired should be sent to the Plant Disease Diagnostic Laboratory at the Extension Research and Education Center at Princeton beginning this month.

Don Herbman, Extension plant pathologist at Princeton, said all applied nematode work is being switched from the University of Kentucky College of Agriculture in Lexington to Princeton, upon the retirement of nematode specialist Richard A. Chapman because of the research and education center's close proximity to major soybean acreage.

However, during the changeover, there could be a delay for those who want a soil sample analysis in early January.

"We are currently setting up our laboratory for nematode analysis, Herbman said. "Consequently there may be a delay in response to soil samples sent during the month of January. Moreover, the nematode lab will not be opened fully in January because Paul Bach, our Princeton soil scientist, will be attending a two-week nematode short course at Clemson."

Herbman added, "We at Princeton look forward to providing a nematode service for Kentucky farmers. Please feel free to contact us about their future nematode questions concerning the changing of the guard."
