Persons posing as employees of the Internal Revenue Service occasionally attempt to harass taxpayers or collect money for what the taxpayer claims are unpaid taxes. The IRS says: Taxpayers should request to see the credentials of any individual claiming to represent the IRS. Every IRS employee who makes contact with the public is required to carry distinctive identification and must show this when conducting official business. Taxpayers who use money to the IRS will receive written notification before being contacted in person.
