Funeral services were held Friday, January 27, at the Matthews Funeral Chapel by the Rev. Ron Howard. Burial in Carlisle Cemetery.

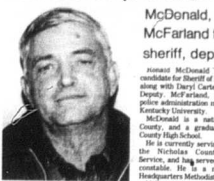
