Funding for four roads is approved

Gov. Morris Laine today has announced that the state has budgeted \$200,000 in the approved Rural Secondary Program for Nicholas County.

This program makes consistent repairs possible to Nicholas County's 54.2 miles of secondary state roads, said Collins. "The formula used to determine budgets for the program takes into consideration the county's land area, rural road mileage and population."

The state will utilize bituminous material and small stone to seal the existing surface on 17 miles of County Road 206, State Highway 4.5 miles of County Road 208, Ball Hill Road, 1.5 miles of County Road 360; Hickory Ridge Road, and 2.2 miles of County Road 323, Pleasant Spring Road.

State Transportation Secretary Fred C. Pore said the program and projects are estimated to cost \$21,302 and to be funded with Rural Secondary Funds. Secretary Pore noted that the projects are expected to be accomplished by contract and will be advertised for bids as soon as possible.
