Kentucky Afield

Bluegill's finest hour

The bluegill is one of the most popular and widely distributed species in Kentucky. It's found throughout the state - in small streams, creeks, ponds, and even in big rivers and large ponds. But often times this scrappy little fish is overlooked because of its reputation as a nuisance. And it's a shame too, because the bluegill is one of the most versatile and hardiest of gamefish. It's also one of the most popular and widely distributed species in Kentucky.

Bluegills feed mostly on insects, larvae, fish eggs, water mites, worms, and the fry of fishes. They have glutinous appetites which they serve up to satisfy. Bluegills are occasionally on the move, except during the spawn, when they become territorial.

If you want to catch a mass of bluegill, the best few weeks after the end of the best fishing of the year because bluegill prefer shallow water throughout the spring and summer. Spawning occurs usually in May, when water temperatures reach into the 70s. Bluegill nests are anchored and clustered to colonies.

Soil moisture 26 percent short despite rains
Spring rainfalls continue to progress rapidly throughout Kentucky. Watershed soil moisture is now 26 percent adequate, but work is still well ahead of normal in most areas.

Most of Central and Eastern Kentucky could use additional rainfall. At week's end soil moisture was reported 29 percent short, 42 percent adequate and 13 percent surplus.
