The Nicholas County track team had its best performance in the State Track and Field Meet Saturday in Lexington, winning six of its seven events.



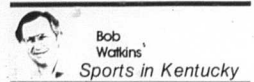
### NCHS track team qualifiers

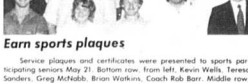

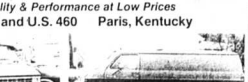
