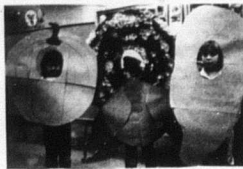
**MRS. JESSE M. TUCKER**

Plans for the adult classes being offered by the Nicholas County Board of Education have been completed, according to Bill Guttone, coordinator of the classes.

Interest was especially high for the computer and word processing classes resulting in the possibility of a second class in basic computers to be offered in the spring, he said. Due to the limitation on the number of computers and the material to be presented, numbers in the classes were held to 15 students.

The Basic Computer class will be on Dec. 2 from 6:30 to 9 p.m. The Word Processing class will be held on Dec. 16 at the same time. Both classes will meet in the Computer Center which is in a relocatable classroom unit behind the Nicholas County Elementary School.

The class in 35 mm Photography will meet on Jan. 6, 1986 at the Nicholas County Board of Education, also from 6:30 p.m. Other classes being planned at this time include typing and general bookkeeping. They will be offered during the second semester of this school year in order to avoid the possibility of inclement weather. Unlike the other classes, these will last for up to 12 weeks (not one night weekly). Those who have signed for these classes will be notified of specific dates and times later.
