The Historical Society has 211 members at present, with an additional 92 members who have not paid their June 1985-June 1986 dues as yet.

The annual membership drive is underway, and interested persons are invited to join. Dues, donations and deposit rentals are used to maintain the re-created Carlisle Passenger Depot for community use, provide historical programs and to support the Nicholas County Museum in Barlow, and other county history projects.

The Depot is available free of charge for civic activities. It is also available for private groups for reunions, showers, wedding receptions, etc., at a minimal charge of \$15.00.

Both active and inactive members are being sought, according to Jean W. Custer, president. "Dues support the Society whether a member has time to devote or not," she said.
