- VEGETABLE SALAD
1 lb. carrots, sliced thin
1 green pepper, sliced
2 tomato slices, sliced
1 cucumber, sliced
1/2 head celery, cut in small pieces
1 egg cauliflower, separated into small pieces
1 cup brussels sprouts

- DRESSING
1 cup tomato sauce
1/2 cup vinegar
1/2 cup oil
1/2 cup sugar
1/2 cup mayonnaise
1/2 cup ketchup
1/2 cup mustard
1/2 cup catsup
1/2 cup soy sauce
1/2 cup Worcestershire sauce
1/2 cup lemon juice
1/2 cup lime juice
1/2 cup apple cider vinegar
