Eye Openers

The word "squint" has two different meanings in the treatment of vision problems. The common use of "squint" generally refers to the partial closing of an eye, or eyes, in order to see more clearly. Squinting is particularly prevalent among nearsighted individuals who do not wear glasses that would enable them to see clearly. A squint also refers to a deviating eye, that is, an eye which is uncoordinated with its mate and wanders off in a different direction. This type of squint is more than unattractive. Useful vision in a deviating eye can be diminished or even permanently shut off, as the brain suppresses what is seen to avoid double vision. In either case, squint needs professional attention. The nearsighted or myopic patient will stop squinting when his or her vision is corrected with glasses. The patient with a deviating eye needs treatment with glasses, vision training, or both.
