

## Dairy Queen break-in Tuesday night, April 1

Thieves broke into the Dairy Queen Tuesday night, April 1 around 11:30. The break-in was not discovered until 9:30 Wednesday morning when manager Don Short arrived to open up.

A small window in the side of the building was broken out, glass had been knocked out of the back door, and a forced entry made. The freezer and refrigeration doors were open. The hose on the defrost drain on the freezer had been disconnected, causing about eight inches of ice to form in the bottom. Petty cash was missing as well as two screw drivers, hammer and tape measures.

State Police investigating the robbery were able to get finger prints from the cash register and on a tank

beneath the broken window. Short was informed it would be about two weeks before the prints and other information gathered would be processed.
