Visual Skills

Many skills are part of the complex function we call vision. If natural development of them has not been ideal, they can be improved by visual training. Among the necessary skills are:

- DEPTH PERCEPTION - the ability to judge relative distances of objects and to see and move accurately in three-dimensional space.
- PERIPHERAL VISION - the ability to see and interpret what is happening off to your side while seeing straight ahead of you.
- BINOCLARITY - the ability to use both eyes together in a coordinated, simultaneous, accurate way.
- TRACKING - the ability to follow a moving object smoothly.
- FIXATION - the ability to locate and see a series of stationary objects in sequence.
- FOCUS CHANGE - the ability to look quickly from near to far - or from far to near - without blurring vision.

Only a complete eye examination can discover deficiencies in these basic visual skills, so that corrective action can be brought to you as a community service by...
