Health Tips

CHICKEN POX Many illnesses have a long record of being seasonal. Among them is Chicken Pox, a very contagious viral infection. It is seen more commonly among children and occurs most frequently in winter and early spring in three to four year cycles.

The illness begins suddenly with slight fever, loss of appetite, and a general feeling of discomfort. Within 24 hours it has progressed to a slightly red rash that is usually seen in crops which become teardrop shaped surrounded by a reddened area. The rash rapidly becomes crusty within 14 to 18 hours. Most lesions are crusted within five to ten days.

Some children have two or three lesions and little sign of illness. Others have multiple lesions externally as well as on the mucous membranes and have conjunctivitis. These children may have severe itching, fever, and swollen lymph glands.

Treatment is symptomatic. It may include taking soothing baths followed by calamine lotion to relieve itching. Warm saline (salt water) is a soothing mouth rinse for oral lesions. Non-aspirin products may be used to relieve pain and your physician if coughing, shortness of breath, chest pain, or other signs of serious illness occur.

Patients should be kept from school and others outside the home until all lesions are crusted, or approximately seven days. Never expose one with chicken pox to pregnant women, infants, or those with eczema or cancer.

Crusted lesions usually last 10 to 14 days. The average time is 14 to 21 days. Infection occurs by direct contact to moist lesions or articles which have freshly inoculated them and inhalation of nose and throat secretions.
