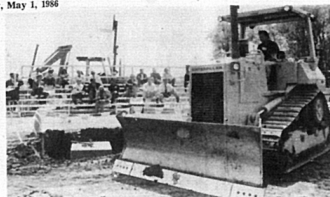


The Star of the Show

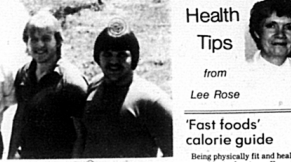
