Nicholas County, Kentucky has filed with the Department of Local Government, a Revenue Sharing Use Report covering Revenue Sharing expenditures from July 1, 1985 to June 30, 1986. The use report and supporting documentation are available for public inspection at the Office of the County Judge/Executive from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday thru Friday.

The families which are sought have a stable home life, flexibility in their approaches to the problems solving, acceptance, and commitment to the child they adopt. Special children need special love.
