peak days uses 600,000. The city water treatment plant can treat only 600,000 to 650,000 gallons per day. He then said, "You can see what the problem is."
Worthington offered his ideas on two solutions:
1. Let Knitting use the city's present eight inch waterline to Licking River for their discharge water to Licking. The allowable chloride level is higher when discharged into a large body of water such as Licking. The city could then build a 24 inch line for its use. The 24 inch line would give the city more 2. There is a new water plant in Fleming County which Worthington says is only pumping at one-third capacity. He suggests that Carlisle could hook up to some of their lines and buy water from the Fleming County facility.
