**Resurfacing on KY 386 scheduled**

A road improvement is planned for Kentucky 386 in Nicholas County, according to Gov. Martha Layne Collins. The state will resurface 2.1 miles of KY 386, the KY 13-U.S. 60 road. "Continued upgrading and repairs are essential to our secondary roads," said Collins. "Proper maintenance is the key to minimizing deterioration that can lead to hazardous road conditions."

State Transportation Secretary C. Leslie Dawson said the project is estimated to cost \$9,257 and is being financed with Rural Secondary
