**ORDINANCE NO. 7, 1986**

**AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AN AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAX ON ALL MOTOR VEHICLES BY THE CITY OF CARLISLE, KENTUCKY.**

**FOR THE YEAR OF 1986.**

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable to adopt an ad valorem tax for motor vehicles and to provide for a more equitable and uniform method of assessing such taxes, and

WHEREAS, if sufficient time had been allowed for the presentation of objections and amendments before the adopted rate was to be levied, it is deemed in the best interests of the City of Carlisle, Kentucky, that the same be levied as provided herein.

IT IS ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF CARLISLE, KENTUCKY:

1) That the ad valorem property tax rate for the year 1986 on motor vehicles as levied shall be 22 cents on each one hundred dollars of motor vehicle value as assessed by the property value administrator of said City.

2) That all taxes levied shall be for the general expenses of the City of Carlisle, Kentucky, and the same shall not be levied for any other purpose than that for which they are levied.

3) That the city clerk shall certify that the ad valorem property tax rate as levied is in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance and that the same shall take effect as of January 1, 1987, after its passage by the City of Carlisle, Kentucky.

4) That the ordinance shall take effect as of January 1, 1987, after its passage by the City of Carlisle, Kentucky.

**Dial toll-free for air quality**

A toll-free telephone line giving reports on the air quality in the Commonwealth is now in operation. The number, 1-800-414-6467, is answered 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

A 60-second message gives the caller the pollutant index number for representative areas of the Commonwealth. The index indicates whether the air quality is in the good, moderate or unhealthy category. An acceptable or good-to-better index is 99; above 100 is an unhealthy index. The message also identifies the pollutant that is responsible for determining the index number.

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
