The Kentucky Grocers Association will hold its 45th Annual Convention and Trade Show on Sept. 26, 27 and 28 at Lexington Center's Heritage Hall.

However, a Chi-Angus cross owned and shown by Todd Day of Carlisle, was judged FFA grand champion and overall reserve champion of the annual Bluegrass District, 4-H and FFA Steer Show and Sale held Sept. 18 at Bluegrass No. 7 Stockyards in Lexington.
The 1,280 pound steer was purchased by Carlisle HIA and Garrett's Furniture for \$11 a pound.
The only other entry from Nicholas County was a 1,140 Chi-Angus owned by Jamie Simons who showed in the 4-H division. Jamie's entry was sponsored by Carlisle Southern States and PCA.
Highest price of the sales went to a straight Angus steer owned by Gerry Dutton of Woodford County. It weighed 1,130 pounds and sold for \$6.41 per pound.
The 441 division winner - a 1,220 pound Chi-Angus/Omaha - was named overall show champion. The owner, Richard Madden of Bourbon County, is a close friend of Day.
Day's steer was bought from Bill Bowers of Eaton, Ohio last October.
