Seat restraints may save your child

Even though most people know that using car safety seats is the only way to save their children's lives...

Parents are under the misconception that they can leave themselves and hold a child, but that is impossible in collisions that take place at more than 5 miles per hour.

Many other car crashes occur because of a loose piece in the car, letting any piece in the car to fly around when an accident occurs.

Death is the permanent way to take away a child's freedom.
