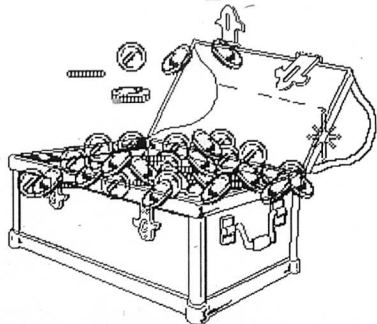

Schools to give annual tests May 5-7; tips offered

From Nicholas County Schools
 Schools in Nicholas County will give annual tests to students on May 5, 6 and 7, 1987. All students in Nicholas County Elementary School and Nicholas County High School will be taking the standardized test, KEST, required by the State Department of Education and the Board of Education.

This testing program is very important to your child since the results from it will be used to make decisions about the educational program. Many decisions about individual students are made based on the results of this testing program.

Parents need to be fully aware of the importance of having their children in school on each of these three days so that the test can be given under the best possible conditions. Make-up tests will be given on May 8 and 11.

These make-up tests are administered by someone other than the regular classroom teacher and are often given somewhere other than in the child's regular classroom.

We do not feel that children have a chance to do as well on the make-up test.

There are some things that parents can do to see that their children have the best possible chance to do well on the standardized testing dates.

It is very important that your child go to bed early and get a good night's sleep on the nights prior to the testing.

If your child does not eat breakfast at school, you should insist that they eat a balanced breakfast before coming to school on these testing dates.

If your child eats breakfast at school, he/she will have a good breakfast.
