Green picked as top area science teacher

Kathy Green, biology teacher at Nicholas County High School, has been recognized as the outstanding senior high science teacher for the Northeastern Regional Science Fair for the past two years.

She has also been recognized by the Kentucky Academy of Science in 1986 and 1987 for her outstanding service at the senior high level.

Green has sponsored entrance into the regional fair since 1982 and has had three students place first overall in the event - Pam Sparks in 1984, Dawn Letcher in 1985 and Tamilla Anderson in 1986. She has also had students place second on two occasions, one student place third and two place fourth.

Five students from the school have earned the right to advance to the International Science and Engineering Fair and Green will accompany Tamilla Anderson to San Juan, Puerto Rico in May for the competition.

Several students have won college scholarships as a result of the competition and Green's tutelage. They are Sherry Pryor (1982), Keith Lyons (1983), Dawn Letcher (1985) and Patty Browning (1987). Sunny Johnson, currently a senior at the school, has been awarded a Department of Energy research award to attend the University of California at Berkeley this summer.

Several students have taken part in the University of Louisville Science Symposium with four students becoming semi-finalist and one student, Leslie Thornton in 1987, being a finalist.

Letcher won a scholarship to the University of Louisville and will attend the national symposium at West Point, New York this summer.
