Bentz unfolds water grant status.....

Martin called city superintendent Gayle Yastandingham. Yastandingham said he was coming at 10:30 a.m. with the report.
Bentz said Martin plans to fight Yastandingham's opposition, and the mayor said, "The (Martin) inside."
Bentz said Martin had told him, he and Yastandingham are good friends, but if it is necessary to fight this eye-to-eye, Martin is going to do that.
Senator Ed Ford (D-Cynthiana) was in Nevada at the time of the meeting, but according to sources close to the situation, Ford was unaware Yastandingham would pose such a fight.
City commission Clarence Cord said, "The way I understand it, it is the package including the grant being before any committee."
Cord added he understood that if the governor had approved the project it didn't have to go before any committee.
Bentz blasted television coverage of this committee's meetings, saying the report gives merely a partial view of Yastandingham and not that of the city.
"I was on the stand longer than representative Yastandingham," he said.
According to Bentz, Yastandingham spoke to the committee on what he (Yastandingham) says are the city's problems.

The letter basically stated his disapproval of the plan to discharge waste from the city into the Lacking River.
"At that time the proposal was to not only discharge Jockey's waste into the Lacking but everything from the City of Carlisle," Bentz said.
"We altered the plan to eliminate waste from the city," Bentz said.
In a September 15 letter to Yastandingham, Mademson said: "I want to give the impression that you think the city of Carlisle and Jockey intend to dump polluted waste into the drinking water of downtown people. Both is not the case. Jockey is not a polluter and does not want to conduct its operation to harm the environment."
A substantial number of our employees reside in Fleming, Mason and Robertson counties. Their jobs and others depend on Jockey's continuous operation moving both state and federal equipment to the plant. We have been working with the Kentucky Natural Resources and Environmental Resources Cabinet to meet tight state standards. Our compliance program has been recognized with the EPA award.
We share your concern for the environment and certainly do not want to adversely impact the water quality of the Lacking River. About two weeks later, Yastandingham introduced his plans to the public meeting, but has since apparently taken a different stand.

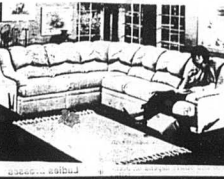
