CONGRESS SHOULD RECOGNIZE THE CHEROKEE TRAIL OF TEARS

I have asked the Congress to officially recognize an important part of the history of our state - the Trail of Tears running through Kentucky on a wandering course from North Carolina to Oklahoma.

I have introduced a bill to designate the Trail of Tears as a national historic trail. The bill asks that the Secretary of Interior consider placing an interpretive exhibit near Hawksville, Kentucky.

Handfuls and perhaps thousands of Cherokees died during a forced march, which began at Murphy, North Carolina, and progressed through Georgia, Alabama, Tennessee, Kentucky, Illinois, Missouri and Arkansas to Tahlequah, Oklahoma.
