

Maysville Community registration is set for August 19-24 for fall semester

Registration for fall semester classes at Maysville Community College will be held August 19-24 in the college's auditorium.

Returning students, those who attended Maysville Community College last spring semester, will register on August 19 and 20. Registration hours are 9-11:30 a.m. and 1-3:04 p.m.

New students, those attending Maysville Community College for the first time and those who did not attend college classes during the spring semester, will be registered Friday and Monday, August 21 and 24 during the same hours.

Saturday registration will be held August 22 from 10 a.m. - 2 p.m. Evening registration will be open August 24 from 6-8 p.m. Those wishing to register for Saturday classes, evening classes, and regularly scheduled daytime classes may do so during Saturday and evening registration times.

Maysville Community College has expanded its weekend college offerings with eight classes being offered on Saturdays. Photography, Writing I, Nutrition, Developmental Psychology, and Applied Math will be offered on Saturday mornings from 9-11:30 a.m.

Writing II, U. S. History, and Elementary Algebra will be offered on Saturday afternoons from 12:30-3 each week. A complete schedule of Fall 1987, Spring 1988, and Summer Session 1988 class offerings at Maysville Community College is now available and may be obtained at the college's Student Services Office.

Fees for the 1987-88 school year increased slightly over last year's charges. Full-time resident tuition has gone up from \$270 per semester to \$280. Part-time tuition has increased from \$23 per credit hour to \$24 per credit hour.

Even with this slight increase, the tuition to attend Maysville Community College is approximately 1/3 of the fee charged at the U. R. campus.

The Admissions Office is currently accepting applications for admission to Maysville Community College, and the Student Services Office is continuing to process financial aid applications.

Maysville Community College is beginning its twelfth year of service to Buffalo Trace communities with this 1987-88 academic year.

30 - Saltwell-Barterville Road, Saltwell-Headquarters Road to Saltwell Church, Buffalo Trace, Rule Road, east end of Bunker Turppike.

31 - East end of Sugar Creek Road, Elrich-Fryman Lane (Hodnall Lane), Ball Hill Road, Suggs Pike, Mt. Mariah Road, A.M. only: Highway 68 beginning at Lake Road (1450), left on Highway 22 (Old Paris Pike), Old Paris Pike.
