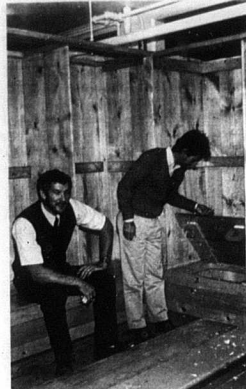

Locker rooms undergo renovation at NCHS

Nicholas County athletes will be breathing a sigh of relief as a satisfactory year draws to a close.
The locker room is in the final stages of renovation and is now being presented a new, shiny face to Nicholas County student athletes.
"Greg Reid, principal of Nicholas County High School, contacted me with what plans he had that he wanted to make work, and after I saw what the area was like I could see it was in pretty bad shape," said Chris Blitche, local craftsman and bus driver.
"After he showed me the picture from the magazine, I worked out all the plans and the amount of lumber and supplies I would need to get the job done.
"I used natural wood, knotty pine, zip-guard, and finished with three coats of polyurethane. Another coat will be added this winter," said Blitche.
The remodeling began in September and involved around 85 hours of work time.
The deadline was October 15, and the project was completed just two days under that date.

The actual work was the lockers. The top is to have clothes and the next doubles as a place to lock personal belongings so that nothing will be found missing after practice or during game time.
"There are 12 standard lockers that are large enough for two people to share.
"Around the sides are dead spaces that filled with two extra lockers. That was in the original plan.
"These may be used to hold bandages if one of the players happens to be hurt and for the coach's personal belongings. We also installed new mats and trays after I was advised on which to purchase," Blitche explained.
A new table was also built for practical purposes such as a place to lay an injured player and to determine game plans.
Another new addition was an extra door put in place to lock when the locker room was not in use and during game time when personal belongings are in the locker room unattended.
