There are many Central Kentuckians in the Army, Navy, Air Force and Marines who are stationed around the world during the Christmas holidays.

Last Thursday, a Lexington newspaper printed names and addresses of these servicemen stationed in various parts of the world.

A Nicholas County teacher saw a need for these servicemen to give some Christmas spirit and decided to follow through with a plan that enabled some of them to receive just this.

Mrs. Judy Hawkins, a second

grade teacher at Nicholas County Elementary, wrote a few letters to those selected names to explain the cards, letters and drawings that her second grade classroom would write them.

Another teacher, Elaine Broderick, learned of the project and decided to do the same.

"On the day that we wrote to the children, draw helicopters, airplanes and other things that have to do with what they thought of the Air Force."

"Other days, when we did someone from the Army, we sent pictures of tanks and jeeps and so on."

"Also, a sailor could receive anything from a drawing of small boats to submarines," Hawkins said.

Broderick added, "I think the children were really concerned and interested about the people they were writing."

Broderick said they had those in the armed forces hobbies and interests and where they were from so the children knew them a little better and could respond to their interests.

"A few of the kids even wrote that they wanted a reply back," she said.

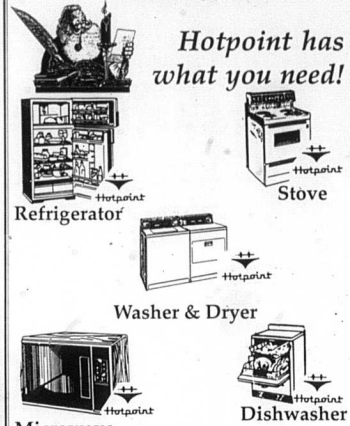
The deadline for delivery of mail to Europe and Far East ended December 4.
