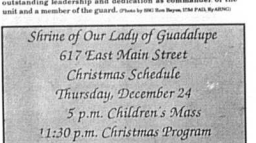

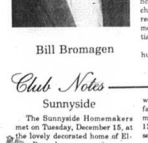

For most individuals, this number is the individual's social security number. If the dependent has a social security number, but the taxpayer does not know what it is, the taxpayer should contact a local Social Security Administration office.

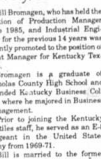
